As the Activities Coordinator it is my role to work closely with each group and establish a program of varied, and interesting activities.

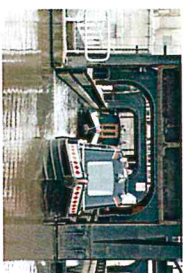
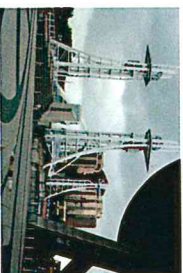
A majority of the meetings will be at the designated venue. Previous activities for individual groups have included;
